University of Wisconsin Rock County Law Enforcement Protection and Services Funding Distribution Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement

Supervisor Knudson moved approval of the above resolution, second by Supervisor Fell. ADOPTED.

Update on e-Filing in the Clerk of Court Office. Ms. Gackstatter informed the Committee they are required to have all cases scanned for e-Filing by the end of 2017. She said this is a big undertaking for her department and requires a great deal of time. The state will be

providing additional servers for her office and the Judges will all have dual monitors to bring the information up. Ms. Gackstatter said she thinks Rock County will be brought online sometime in the third quarter. Judge Dillon explained this is mandated by the Supreme Court.

Supervisor Owens suggested having the Clerk of Court Office report to the County Board at a future meeting so other Supervisors will have more of an understanding on what her office does.

Ms. Gackstatter said her department currently has 3,400 open case to backload and this project goes hand-in-hand with the new redaction laws. Her office has a vacancy and Ms. Gackstatter is having her staff work overtime in order to meet the e-File deadline.
