

10.A. Purchase of Agricultural Conservation Easements (PACE) Program.

County Conservationist, Tom Sweeney thanked the Board for the opportunity to present the PACE (Purchase of Agricultural Conservation Easements) Program tonight. He introduced Rock County Planner Carrie Houston, who delivered the presentation

The PACE Program is a voluntary County program that compensates agricultural landowners for restricting the potential future uses of their land. The County purchases an agricultural land parcel's "development rights" (agricultural conservation easement) from willing, eligible owners. The monetary difference between the appraised value of the parcel for agricultural use and the appraised value of the parcel for its "highest and best use" (e.g. development) is the value of the parcel's "development rights." This is the monetary amount the Program will pay the landowner to purchase the parcel's "development rights."

Landowner retains ownership of the land, but future use is bound to easement terms (i.e land to be utilized for agriculture and not "developed") Federal and State funds, in which to purchase agricultural conservation easements, are available.

The Rock County Board of Supervisors authorized a PACE Ad Hoc Committee and tasked the committee with developing a County PACE Program in February of 2009. The Ad Hoc Committee was made up of 21 members, representing a cross section of parties interested in and affected by the formation of the Program, including elected officials, government employees, leaders in the business/industry and non-profit fields and others. The Program was coordinated through the County Planning, Economic & Community Development Agency. Program implementation will be undertaken by the County Land Conservation Department.

The Program has three main goals. First, is to identify, prioritize, and preserve productive agricultural lands in the County, second, to promote a regional land use and planning and development vision, and thirdly, to encourage intergovernmental communication and cooperation.

On November 18, 2010, County Board members received the 56-page manual that defines the program deliverables in more detail. Ms. Houston spent some time going over program eligibility and priority and shared several maps and program definitions. This can be viewed on the County Website at: http://www.co.rock.wi.us/index.php/draftplanningdocuments as well as more contact information.

Ms. Houston explained that the maps were created with LESA (Land Evaluation and Site Assessment) which utilizes a comprehensive, objective methodology to develop a LESA Score for land parcels, evaluating suitability for various uses LESA answers the question, "What lands are suitable (and conversely, unsuitable) for inclusion in the Rock County PACE Program?" Maps were viewed. The Committee analyzed the LESA Scores Map, and then identified Primary Target Acquisition Areas, which are clusters of eligible agricultural parcels with high LESA scores and under moderate development pressure. These areas are the lands on which the Program will focus its easement acquisition efforts.

The Program is set to be implemented by the County Land Conservation Program and will consist of three major steps

- 1 Undertake landowner education and outreach, and review and evaluate easement applications from landowners
- 2. Submit select applications to State and Federal programs for easement acquisition funding.
- 3 Acquisition of agricultural conservation easements Question and Answer time followed the report/presentation.
