



Executive Summary
Authorizing Submission of Project Safe Neighborhoods Grant Application

The Office of Justice Assistance has announced a grant opportunity titled "PSN Western District (2010)." Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) is a nationwide effort to reduce gun crime and gang violence. Rock County agencies are eligible to apply for a maximum of \$25,847.

This is a competitive grant with limited eligibility. The programs to be funded must be geared toward projects that demonstrate an effort to reduce gang, gun, or violent crime in the Western District of Wisconsin. Projects that are collaborative or projects that have an emphasis on information sharing will receive preference.

The intent of the Sheriff's Office is to submit a joint application with the Beloit Police Department and the Janesville Police Department in the amount of \$25,847. No local match is required.

This resolution authorizes the Sheriff's Office to submit an application for the Project Safe Neighborhoods grant.
