AWARDING CONTRACT FOR PURCHASE OF RADIO EQUIPMENT FROM 2008-2009 HOMELAND SECURITY MUTUAL AID RADIO REPLACEMENT GRANT: ROUND 6 (2008-2009)



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Rock County applied to the State of Wisconsin, Office of Justice Assistance (OJA) for the 2008-2009 Homeland Security Mutual Aid Radio Replacement Grant in the amount of \$39,398 including local match, for the purpose of enhancing radio communications interoperability.

Rock County has identified the need for radio equipment and made application on behalf of agencies that were eligible for funding per the Office of Justice. The agencies include 8 radios for the City of Janesville Police Department, 1 radio for the Town of Milton Fire Department, 7 radios for the City of Edgerton Fire Department, 2 radios for the City of Edgerton Police Department, 3 radios for the City of Evansville Police Department and 2 radios for the Rock County Sheriff's Office.

Emergency Management will utilize these grant funds to purchase P25 Portable and P25 Mobile Radios for the above agencies. Emergency Management will also serve as the fiscal agent.

Bandt Communications of Janesville is the authorized vendor under State of Wisconsin WSCA Bid Contract #02702. It is the recommendation of the Emergency Management Director to award the contract to Bandt using the State contract.
