REAUTHORIZATION OF SELF-INSURANCE

1 WHEREAS, the County of Rock is a qualified political subdivision of the State of Wisconsin; and

2
3 WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Worker's Compensation Act (Act) provides that employers covered
4 by the Act either insure their liability with worker's compensation insurance carriers authorized to do
5 business in Wisconsin, or to be exempted (self-insured) from insuring liabilities with a carrier and thereby
6 assuming the responsibility for its own worker's compensation risk and payment; and

8 WHEREAS, the State and its political subdivisions may self-insure worker's compensation
9 without a special order from the Department of Workforce Development (Department) if they agree to
10 report faithfully all compensable injuries and agree to comply with the Act and rules of the Department;

13 WHEREAS, it is in the County's best interest to approve the continuation of the self-insured
14 worker's compensation program, in compliance with Wisconsin Administrative Code DWD 80.60(3);

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly
18 assembled this 8 day of March, 2012, that the County Board:

20 (1) Provide for the continuation of a self-insured worker's compensation program that
21 is currently in effect.

23 (2) Authorize the County Clerk to forward certified copies of this resolution to the Worker's
24 Compensation Division, Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development.
