**ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF THE CORONER AND
ESTABLISHING A MEDICAL EXAMINER SYSTEM**

- 1 **WHEREAS**, the County Board previously abolished the Office of the Coroner by Resolution 06-8A-
- 2 069, this resolution was later rescinded by Resolution 08-12A-170; and,
- 3
- 4 **WHEREAS**, Article VI, Section 4 of the Wisconsin Constitution provides for the establishment of the
- 5 medical examiner system in lieu of a coroner; and,
- 6
- 7 **WHEREAS**, s. 59 34, Wis. Stats., also provides for the establishment of a medical examiner by the
- 8 County Board; and,
- 9
- 10 **WHEREAS**, it may be possible to establish a medical examiner system at a cost comparable to a
- 11 coroner's office; and,
- 12
- 13 **WHEREAS**, adopting a medical examiner system would allow the County Board more flexibility to
- 14 determine the structure and staffing of the office.

- 16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Rock County Board of Supervisors duly assembled
- 17 this _____ day of _____, 2010 does hereby abolish the position of the coroner and establish a
- 18 medical examiner system, effective January 3, 2011.

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
FISCAL NOTE:
