<u>Discussion of Pending Layoffs of Assistant District Attorneys.</u> Mr. O'Leary said the ADAs are voting today or tomorrow on whether to take the additional furlough days off. He said he will not know the results until 5 p.m. tomorrow. He said he will do everything in his power to keep the office going but he does not know at this time what the impact on his office will be. He said he and other DAs have not been consulted on what this would mean to our offices.

Chair Collins asked if the legislators are involved. Mr. O'Leary said he has talked to them, they understand but don't know what they can do about it.

Committee Requests and Motions.

<u>Discussion on Department Tours.</u> Chair Collins said he had three responses on the tours. 1) Kris Baker Ellis said they would like the Committee to tour Child Support but not until the fall. 2) Shirley Connors said they have not had any changes but the Committee is always welcome. 3) Rita Costrini-Norgal said they have not had any changes but the Committee is always welcome.

Chair Collins said he would like summer meetings put on the next agenda and possibly holding one meeting in July and one in August.

Supervisor Podzilni said he had received a letter from the attorney for the Lake District and he is not happy with Mr. Kuglitsch's letter. We are still waiting for responses from the property owners. Chair Collins asked to have the Slow-No-Wake put on the next agenda.
