Executive Summary

The Rock County Transportation Coordinating Committee (TCC) has amongst its assigned duties to develop and administer the County's Public Transit-Human Services Coordinated Transportation Plan. This plan was adopted by the TCC on December 13, 2013. Because of the extensive nature of the action items identified in the plan implementation will best be accomplished through the establishment of four subcommittees:

- Marketing and outreach sub-committee
- Personal mobility sub-committee
- Bicycle and pedestrian sub-committee
- Transportation advocacy sub-committee

The sub-committees will be comprised of at least three members of the TCC and will act in an advisory manner to the TCC on items related to the previously mentioned areas of focus. Among the responsibilities of each sub-committee will be the solicitation of input from various key community stakeholders.

No County funds are required
