Plan of Review

July 21, 2015 – Minutes

LEPC Chair Loren Lippincott called the Rock County LEPC Plan of Review Sub-Committee meeting to order at 8:05 AM in the County Emergency Operations Center.

Sub - Committee Members present: Chief Loren Lippincott, Gary Schenck, and Robert Swenarski.

Guest: Rick Wietersen, County Health Department

Adoption of Agenda: Motion by Gary Schenck and seconded by Robert Swenarski to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes: Motion by Robert Swenarski and seconded by Gary Schenck to approve the minutes of March 17, 2015.

Review Facility / Battery / Farm Plans:

The Committee reviewed one amended battery plan, four facility removals and ten Facility plans, nine of which were updated facility plans and one new facility plan. The Committee recommended the plans be forwarded to the State for approval with some minor changes. Rick Wietersen will look into vulnerable facilities nearby the new Helena Chemical for possible inclusion into the plan. Gary Schenck asked about whether or not facilities of interest are added in plans based on their vulnerability and proximity. Chief Loren Lippincott did say that the subcommittee had discussed that before but at the time it would be too involved for most facilities. Lippincott stated that GIS is now farther along in its technology/capabilities and that it might be good for some of the more high risk sites. Robert Swenarski suggested that the radius be a 1 mile radius. Gary Schenck agreed and said that for lower risk facilities, even ½ mile to 1 mile would be sufficient, keeping in mind the potentially higher populated areas.
