





- 1881 LEE VOL 2 PG 325 STUMPS OF BEARING TREES GONE. ESTABLISHED CORNER MIDWAY ON SECTION LINE. SET STAKE WITH HARDHEAD ON NORTH AND SOUTH AND SMALLER LIMESTONES EAST AND WEST. SHOWS A DISTANCE OF 2673.66 TO THE SW AND SE CORNERS OF SECTION 27.
- 1887 RUGER VOL 2 PG 413. FOUND STAKE SURROUNDED BY 2 HARDHEAD AND 2 LIMESTONES
