



1868 LOCKE VOL 1 PG 316 FOUND STUMPS OF BEARING TREES AND OLD STAKE, SET BUR OAK STAKE WITH HARD HEADS ON NORTH, SOUTH, SHOWS A DISTANCE OF 2681.91 EAST AND WEST. TO THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 8.

1868 LOCKE VOL 1 PG 321 FOUND CORNER AS SET BY SELF.

FOUND STAKE, SET STAKE AND VOL 2 PG 462 1892 BLEEDORN. SHOWS A DISTANCE OF SURROUNDED IT WITH 4 HARD HEADS. 2695.44 TO THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 8

DUG AND FOUND REMAINS OF STAKE SURROUNDED 1973 LEE VOL 4 PG 593 ON NORTH SOUTH AND EAST BY HARDHEADS 1.7' DEEP. SAME BUT DOES NOT STATE THE TYPE OF MONUMENT THAT HE PLACED.

FOUND STAKE AND 3 HARD HEADS. REFERENCED 1973 LEE VOL 5 PG 16. SAME AND RE-REFERENCED 9/18/1974


1973 LEE VOL 5 PG 49 FOUND STAKE AND HARD HEADS ON NORTH, SOUTH AND EAST REFERENCED SAME.

FOUND CAST IRON MONUMENT THAT IS IN HARMONY WITH REFERENCE PIPES. ADDED 4" RISER.
