



The above is a record and plat of a survey of the east line of M. C. Smith and J. M. Bostwick's land in the village of Monroe in Green County Wisconsin. Said land being the east part of lot 14 and a strip 8 ft wide off the west side of lot 13 by Brand's Donation to Green County. The stone monuments indicated on the plat were used as the basis for the survey - drill holes in the tops of said stones determined the precise points. Jackson and Jefferson streets are not at right angles to Payne and Russell streets into ten minutes as marked out and located on the ground but they are parallel to each other as indicated on the plat. Offsetted 33 ft East from the monuments designated A & B and drew a right line between the points there determined. Offsetted 33 ft west from the monuments designated C & D and drew a right line between points thus determined then on these right lines so determined measured 48 feet north from a right line drawn between monuments B & D and drew a line parallel to it. These several lines are indicated by dotted lines on the plat. Then measured on a right line between the points C & D and found the distance to be 358 ft and 11 inches one inch short of the recorded distance, then established the S. E. corner of Smith and Bostwick's
