Found remains of old stakes & where stumps of both B. 7. had been dug up - the stumps remains are at the right distances & in the right directions from the corner - The corner is 1.35  $\frac{1}{2}$  chains north of the water corner instead of 1.00 south as given in the V.S. survey notes - The corner is in line with the fence running East & with the fence running north.

Found stumps of both B. 7. & B. 8. - The corner was found from the B. 7. stump & it is in line with fence running west & in line with fence running north about 4 in over north of the north fence post of the fence running south there are 2 trees 20 ft between them near the line which had evidently been blazed in the V.S. survey.

The above is a record and plot of a survey made by me on Section 13 Exeter and Sec 18. Brooklyn - Green County - Sept - 9 - 1876
