

I hereby certify the following to be the minutes of a Survey of the alteration of a part of the River Road on the East side of Rock River in town of Rock as follows: to wit: commencing at a point in the East and West quarter line of Section ten (10) of said town, where the center line of the highway recorded on page ten of Book A of highway records of said town crosses said East and West quarter line, At which point of commencement drove a stake and placed lime stones on the East and West sides of it, and took witness trees Burr Oak 10  $35^{\circ} E$  60 Burr Oak 13  $N 82 \frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$  51, thence  $S 37^{\circ} 10' W$  5.60 chains to a stake with lime stones on East and West sides, thence  $S 54^{\circ} 10' W$  13.71 chains to a stake with lime stones on East and West sides, thence  $S 31^{\circ} 30' W$  4.18 chains to a stake with lime stones on East and West sides, took witness trees Burr Oak 14  $N 8^{\circ} 50' E$  98  $\frac{1}{2}$  Burr Oak 10  $S 36^{\circ} 15' W$  100  $\frac{1}{2}$ , thence  $S 6^{\circ} 16' W$  23.83 chains to a stake with lime stones on East and West sides, said stake is on the line between Sections ten and fifteen of said town, and 50 links East of the Meander corner on the East bank of Rock River thence  $S 0^{\circ} 05' W$  39.98 chains to a stake with lime stones on East and West sides, said stake being on the East and West quarter line of section fifteen of said town, took witness trees Elm 17  $N 87^{\circ} W$  94 Poplar 11  $N 88^{\circ} 50' E$  46  $\frac{1}{2}$  thence  $S 6^{\circ} 45' W$  13.69 chains to a stake with lime stones on East and West sides, said stake being at the Northern terminus of the highway recorded on pages 5 & 6 of Book A of highway records of said town of Rock - Distances to witness trees given in links - Variation of the Needle  $6^{\circ}$  East - courses given per true Meridian
