



The above is a record and plat of a survey
made by me on section 8 Town 3. Range
9 from January 10 to 14 inclusive
1884 -

Surveyed the N + S 1/4 line of Dec. 15 Town of Johnston. and drove
stakes every 40 rods along said 1/4 line to define the center line of
highway. Also drove stakes 37 1/2 links E + W. of said N + S 1/4 line at the
center of the section & at the N. line of the S 1/2 of the S. W 1/4 of said Dec. drove stakes
37 1/2 links west of said line. These stakes refer to the highway & have nothing to do
with land corners. At the SW corner of said Dec. found corner as set by me
in former survey - on page 203. At N. W. corner of said section found the remains of
back of the stone of the highway bridge. The road had been dug down so that
all traces of the old stake were gone - At hand head stone 12x8x4 & 11x4 hand head
stone & 1 lime stone - Surveyed Feb. 12 - 1884 Edward Ruyter, County Surveyor
