

from the upper surface of the skewback, next to the wall, at the North west corner of the South abutment of said highway bridge across Rock river, to the upper surface of a large and permanent stone monument located in Center Avenue, in line with the east sides, and mid-way between the Elm trees, near the South west corner of Claron Street and said Center Avenue, said stone monument was planted in the ground so that its upper surface was about five feet below the surface of the ground. It is about five feet long by twelve inches square, and smoothly dressed on its upper surface, into which are cut the letters "D. M." The upper surface of said Monument is three feet and two hundred and twenty five thousandths of a foot (3.225 ft.) above a horizontal plane. Eight inches above the upper surface of the skewback, next to the wall, at the North west corner of the South abutment of said highway bridge across Rock river at Moultrie.
