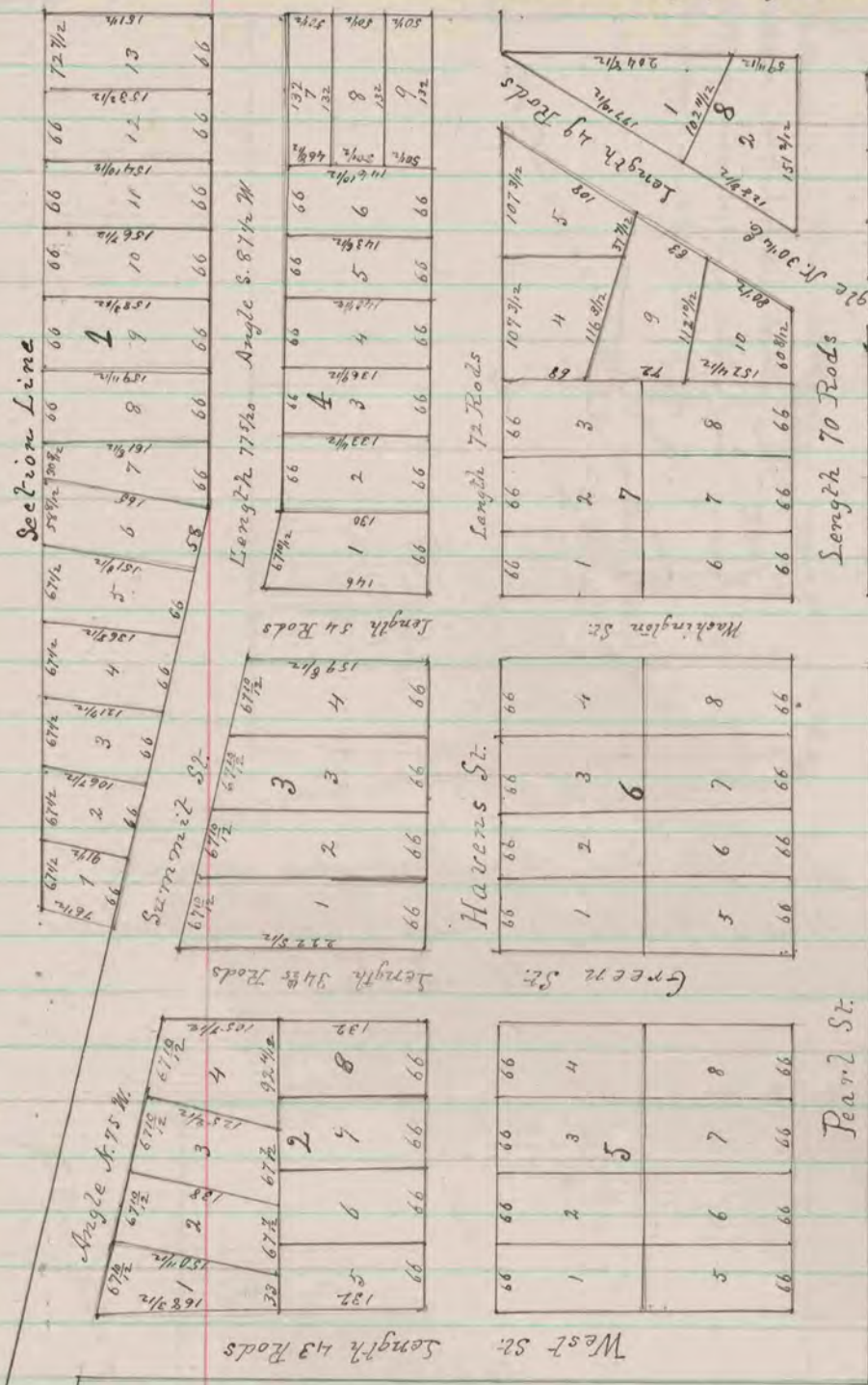


Recorded at 100 Rock P.M. Sept. 6 1853

N. B. Plat of the town of Dayton, situated on Section No. 14 Township No. 4 N. R. 8 East

All streets in the plat are four rods wide and the figures placed at the sides of the lots designate the number of feet each side, is its length. The survey of the town corners set & stone planted at the N.E. corner of lot No. 4 Block No. 4 and bearing from the N.W. corner of the stone basement of Anson D. Kirkpatrick's flouring mill N. 50 1/2 W. 258. Russell Babtitt surveyor of the County of Warren & State of Michigan do hereby certify that the survey of the town of Dayton was made by one of which the above is the plat, is accurately made.
