LAND OWNER SAID DNR TRAPPED THE BEAVERS AND BLEW UP THEIR DAM LAST WINTER. FROM THE DIGITAL AIR PHOTOS IT APPEARS THAT THE WIDTH OF THE BROOK INCREASED SUBSTANTIALLY BECAUSE OF THE BEAVER DAM. CORNER FALLS IN THE BROOK. SEARCHED BROOK BOTTOM AND ALONG BANK AND DID NOT FIND CUT LIMESTONE. RESTORED CORNER ON LINE & MIDWAY BETWEEN THE NE & SE CORNERS OF SECTION 13 NEWARK TWP AS COLLINS DID.
