




- 1866 LOCKE REMONUMENTATION FIELD NOTES. CORNERS FOR TOWN 2 AND 3 BOTH LOST. SET CORNER FOR TOWN 3 MIDWAY AND ON A RIGHT LINE BETWEEN THE QUARTER CORNERS 1/2 MILE EAST AND WEST. AND SET THE CORNERS FOR TOWN 2 26.4' EAST OF CORNER FOR TOWN 3.
