IN 1871 RUGER DECLARED THE CORNER LOST & ESTABLISHED IT ON LINE FROM THE SE & SW SECTION CORNERS. HE SET LIMESTONE 20X8X4. THE FD LS IS 0.05' IS NORTH OF THE LINE BETWEEN THE SE & SW CORNERS OF SEC 12 AND THE MID POINT IS 0.18 EAST OF THE STONE.
