- 1868 LOCKE REMONUMENTATION FIELD NOTES. INTERSECTED 1/4 LINE FOR TOWN 3. 11 LKS NORTH OF CORNER. FOUND STONE WITH STATE SET BY ANDREW CODDINGTON IN OLD MOUND. CORNER IN CENTER OF HIGHWAY AND IN LINE OF FENCE RUNNING NORTH. SET 1/4 CORNER .66' WEST OF 1/4 CORNER FOR T3N 1/4 MONUMENT MARKED WITH FIG. 2 ON SOUTH FACE. SHOWS A DISTANCE OF 2656.83 TO THE NW CORNER AND 2656.83 TO THE NE CORNER.
- 1877 RUGER VOL 2 PG 234 SHOWS A STONE MONUMENT AND STATES THAT IT IS SOUTH OF A LINE DRAWN FROM SECTION CORNER TO SECTION CORNER. SHOWS A DISTANCE OF 2654.19 TO THE NW CORNER AND 2652.54 TO THE NE CORNER. USED THE CORNER TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 2. SHOWS A DISTANCE OF 2625.09 TO THE CENTER OF SECTION 2.
- 1933 SUNNY VOL 3 PG 235 SET 1" X 36" PIPE IN CONCRETE PAVEMENT 8.0 SOUTH OF CENTERLINE. SHOWS A DISTANCE OF 2656.9 TO THE NW CORNER AND 2656.9 TO THE NE CORNER. SHOWS A DISTANCE OF 2625.1 TO THE FENCE INTERSECTION AT THE CENTER OF SECTION 2.
- 1977 BARNES VOL 6 PG 364 FOUND SUNNY'S PIPE AND REPLACED IT WITH AN ALUMINUM MONUMENT.
- 1979 SCHROEDER VOL 5 PG 531 USED THE SOUTH QUARTER CORNER OF SECTION 35 T3N TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 35. THAT CORNER WAS ESTABLISHED BY USING SUNNY'S PIPE.
- 1988 BARNES A-19 DUG AND FOUND CUT LIMESTONE 26" DEEP 3.0 SOUTH OF CENTER OF PAVEMENT. PLACED MAGNET ON TOP OF STONE. IT APPEARED FROM THE EXCAVATION SITE THAT SUNNY NEVER DUG FOR THE CORNER.
- 1992 BARNES A-19(1) FOUND DOT DISK THAT APPEARED TO PERPETUATE THEIR STATION 379+20.

COMBS CONTACTED ME ABOUT EXISTING TIES. USED OLD OBSERVATIONS AND REDREW TIES TO CLARIFY THINGS.
