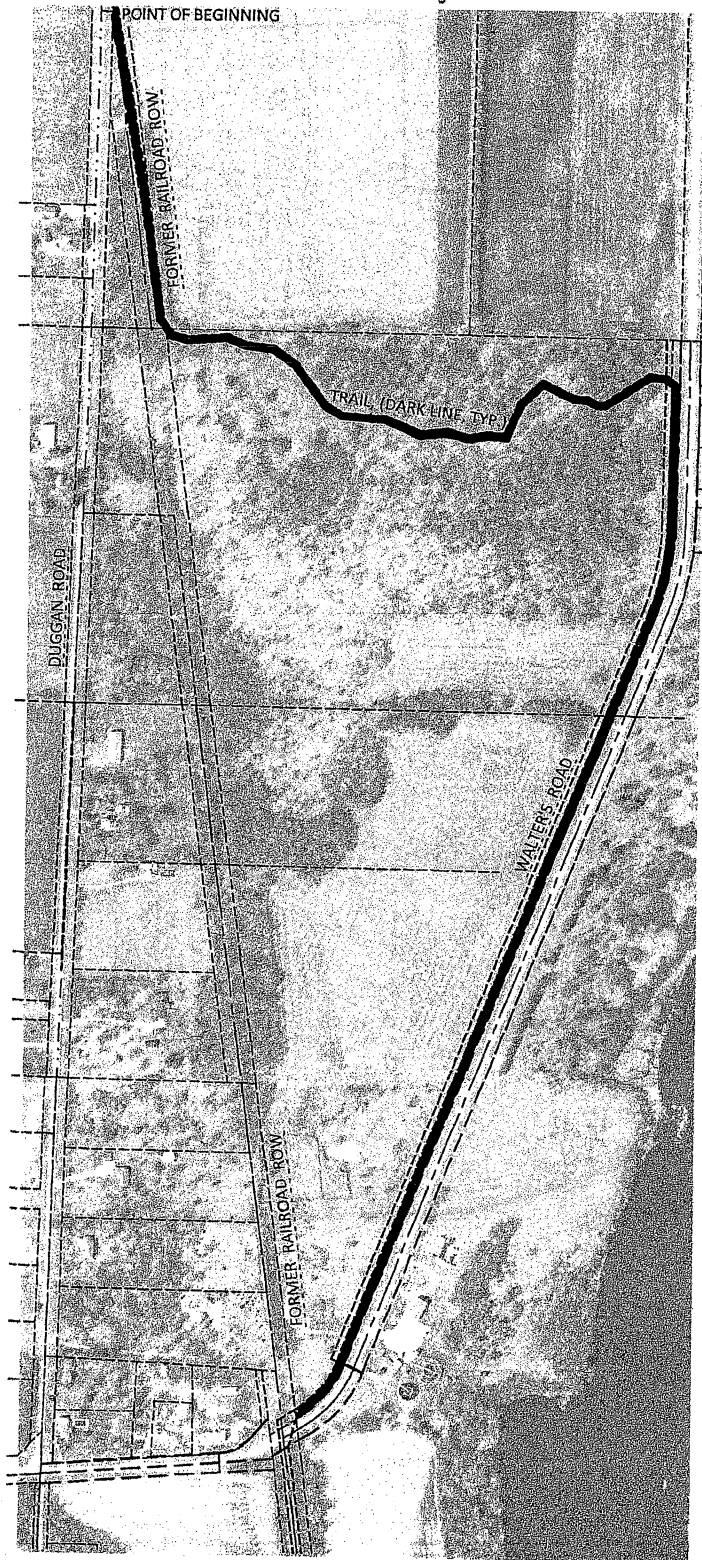

Subject: ATC Funds

Tom and Dewey:

As part of the Alliant Energy Riverside expansion, ATC will be constructing a new transmission line from the plant to the west across the Town of Beloit, where it will meet up with a current transmission line. It has submitted two options to the PSC for approval.

Assuming approval by the PSC, the County would receive a one-time environmental impact fee. If the preferred route is approved, the fee would be \$796,960. If the alternate route is approved, the fee would be \$830,560. The fee would be paid as soon as ATC begins construction, which it plans to do in 2018.

Consequently, for the 2018 budget we should be planning on receiving this funding. Last time we received ATC funds, the County Board chose to split the funds equally between the Land Conservation Department and the Parks Division.

I would suggest that you speak with your committee chair about placing this as a discussion item at an upcoming meeting of your committee, both to update the committee and to seek any input on the use of these funds. This input would be helpful to me as I prepare the 2018 Recommended Budget. Depending on the feedback provided by the committees, we may choose to have further discussions in advance of or during the 2018 budget development process.

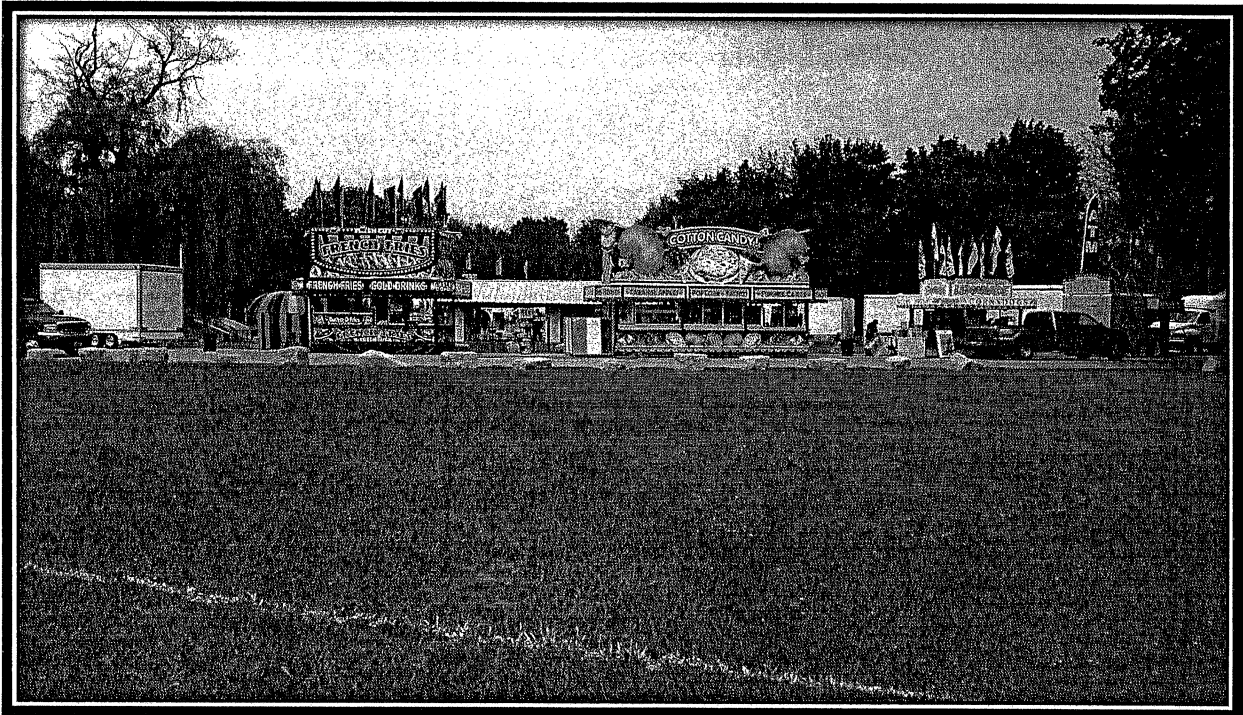

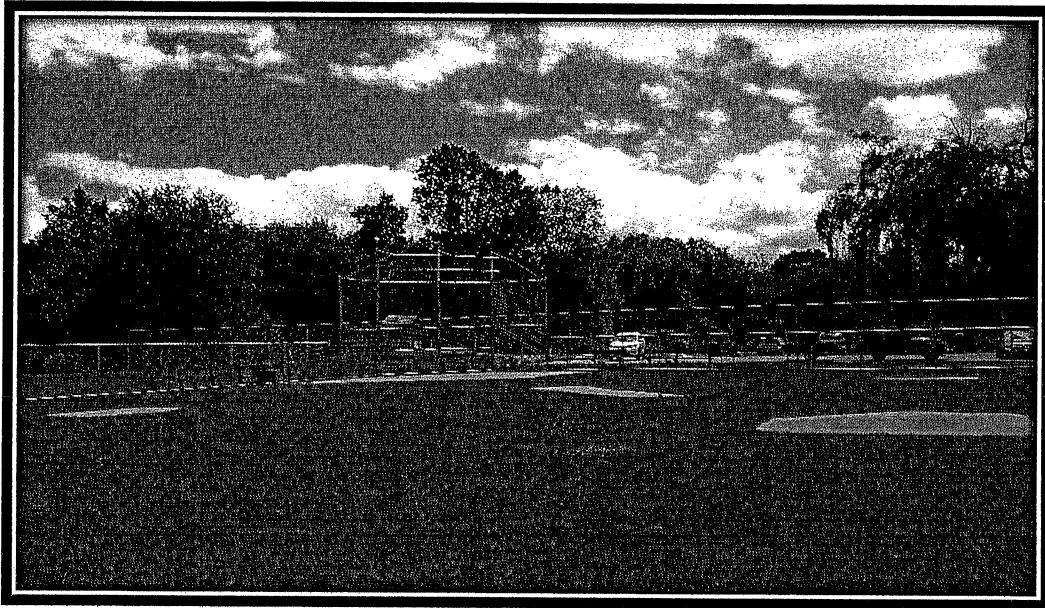

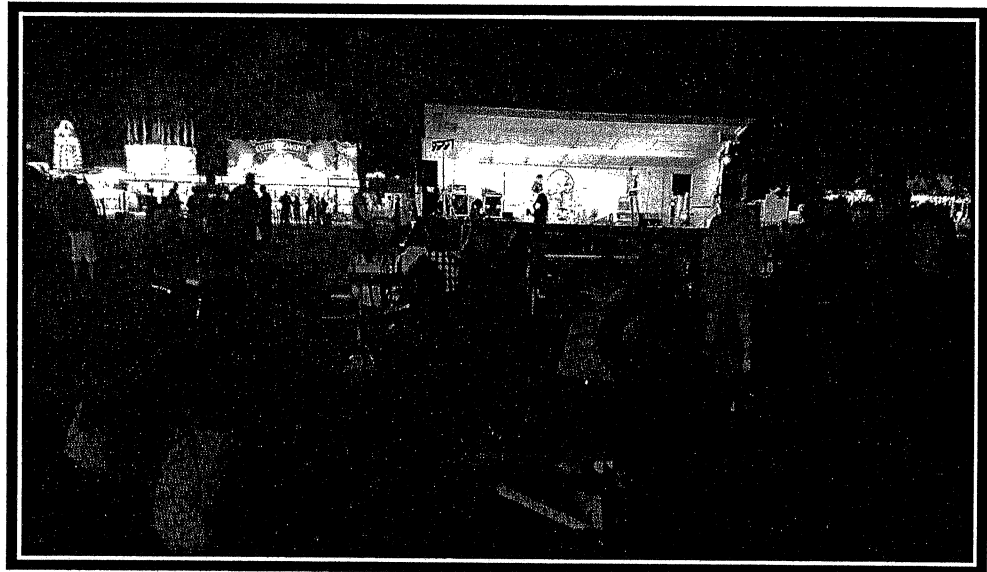
