





ISSUE: Consider approval of Contract Amendment #4 - Additional engineering design services due to floodplain concerns of the Wisconsin DNR and plat revisions for CTH A (USH 14 – E. County Line).


DISCUSSION: In 2015, Rock County contracted with Ayres Associates to provide engineering design services for CTH A (USH 14 – E. County Line). There have been three previous amendments to the contract due primarily to right-of-way/real estate items and floodplain impacts that were not included in the original contract as the impacts for both were not fully known or defined at the time of the original contract.

This fourth amendment relates to the issues listed above: additional floodplain concerns of the Wisconsin DNR and plat revisions. The plat revisions are to help address the floodplain concerns and to address spacing needs for a septic field.

The proposed amendment is for \$35,759.30. Funding for these additional services will be covered within the County Road Construction budget approved for 2021.


County Ordinance 4.531(6), states:

Approval of Rumble Strip Contract

ISSUE: Approve the contract for milling centerline and edge line rumble strips on CTH D (Creedy Rd – Noss Rd).

DISCUSSION: Rock County was notified by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation that CTH D (between Creedy Rd and Noss Rd) was the 22nd highest accident-prone corridor in the state. Safety improvements were identified for this corridor and Rock County was notified of eligibility for a project through the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). The HSIP program funds highway safety projects at sites that have experienced a high crash history. Emphasis is on low-cost options that can be implemented quickly.


Rock County decided to not pursue the design and construction option through the HSIP program and instead implement the safety improvements with our own employees (signage, brushing) and contract out the milling of rumble strips and installation of the pavement markings. This decision was based on timeframe for the work to be completed and cost advantages of completing the work outside the program.

The contract amount to mill centerline and edge line rumble strips for approximately 2 miles of roadway is proposed to be awarded to Payne and Dolan, Inc. in the amount of \$13,405.00

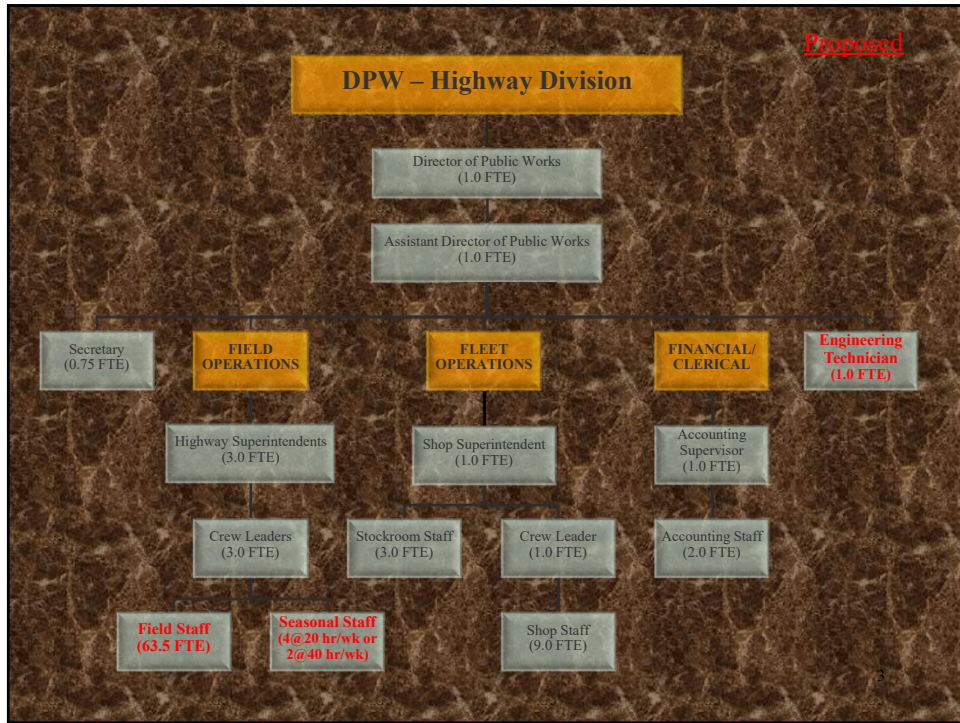

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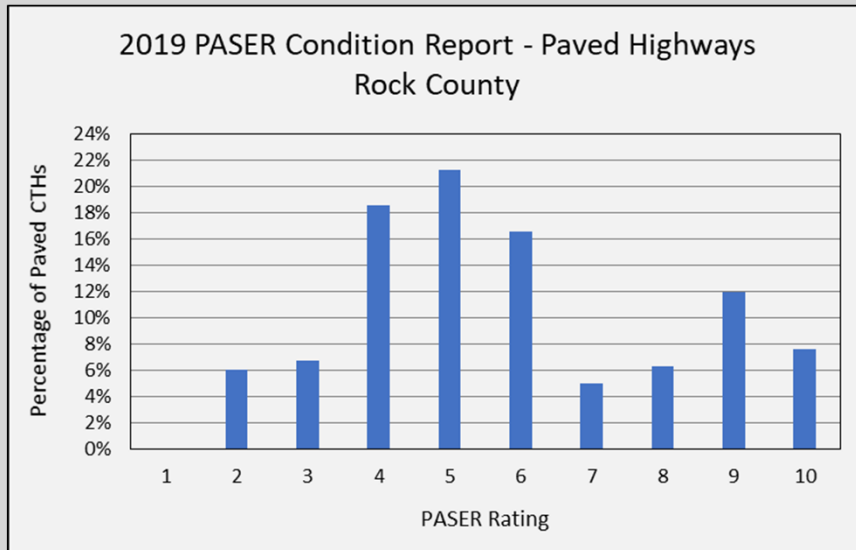
County Highway Condition - 2016



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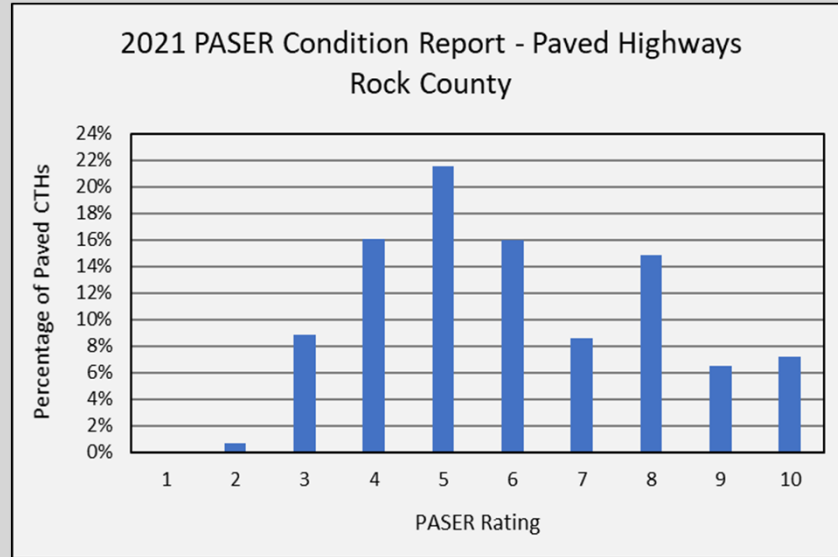
County Highway Condition - 2019



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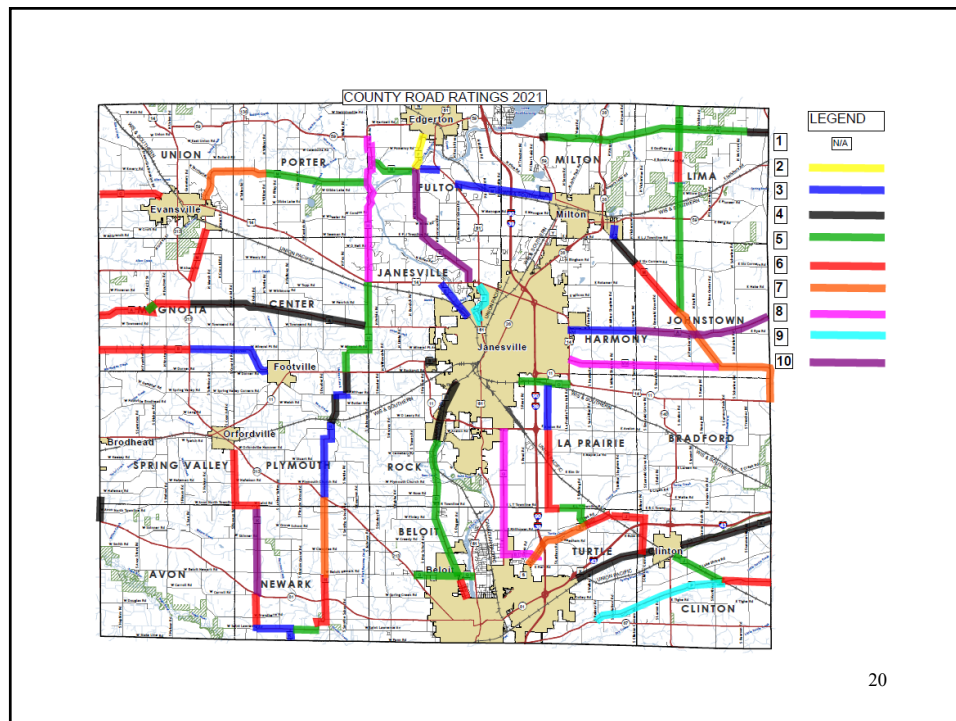
