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





EXECUTIVE SUMMARY AUTHORIZING AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR SPORTSMAN'S PARK PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT

This resolution provides final authorization to award the contract for installation of playground equipment at Sportsman's Park in the amount of \$35,000. This resolution awards the contract to Lee Recreation, who was selected because they had the best equipment and design based on proposals received. The decision was based not only on cost, but also on the overall natural look of the equipment and how it will fit within the park's landscape. Each proposal was ranked using scoresheets that looked at the design and fit within the park, equipment colors, number and variety of play components, recycled material content, safety and ADA accessibility, budget, and insurance requirement.

The site preparation groundwork will be completed by the Rock County Department of Public Works to the bidder's requirements.

Project will be funded through the Parks Capital Improvement Account (Account 41-4592-4800-67200). This project was budgeted at \$35,000. Any site preparation and finish costs furnished by Public Works staff will be covered under the operating budget.

Beckman Mill Memorial Garden

The garden will be in front of the cooperage/museum and will replace the unused "Herb Garden" space next to the Heritage Garden, which is already managed by the Friends of Beckman Mill. The herb garden has fallen to the wayside. They will also take out the composting stalls which have become old and an eyesore in this small area.

The family have become members of the Beckman Mill group and has agreed to maintain the garden and weed the garden every year. They've talked with K&W Greenery who are willing to do the work they've proposed and can start in mid-July with our approval.

Rock County Department of Public Works Division of Parks – Issue Paper

ISSUE: Consider Real Estate License Agreement with Hendricks Land Development, LLC, for land use for the Beloit to Janesville Trail

<u>DISCUSSION:</u> The County has been working with the Hendricks Company in obtaining an easement for public recreational purposes for the Beloit to Janesville Trail. During those discussions the Hendricks group has requested that we use a Real Estate license agreement in place of an easement.

The License agreement is not perpetual and has the potential for a 20-year life span. In addition, there is a license fee of \$10.00 annually for the duration of the agreement.

Action by the Public Works Committee is required to move forward with this Real Estate License Agreement.
