Approval for State/Municipal Agreement for a Highway 26 Improvement Project and Approval for Agreement by and between the Wisconsin Department of Transportation and Rock County for the maintenance of the Bicycle/Pedestrian Path within the Rights of Way of State Highway 26. Supervisors Fox and Arnold moved the

agreements. Lori explained these agreements are for construction and maintenance of a bike path to be part of the STH 26 reconstruction project. The County section will be five miles long from Storrs Lake Road to the county line. There will be no construction cost to the County. Maintenance cost is estimated at \$400 annually going up to \$600 annually in the latter years of the 20-year agreement. Supervisor Fox stated this provides long-term tourism opportunities at little cost to the County. MOTION CARRIED.

Approve Voucher over \$10,000 to Richter Electric for Beckman Mill Lighting Project (\$33,000). Supervisors Bussie and Arnold moved the voucher payable to Richter Electric for \$33,000. MOTION CARRIED.
