IN 1911 HINTZE DID NOT FIND GRAVES' STONE AND HE PLACE A CONCRETE MONUMENT BY USING "SIGNS OF THE U.S.B.T. AND FENCES". IN 1970 BATTERMAN, ROCK COUNTY SURVEYOR, DUG AND FD A LIMESTONE AT THE SE COR OF SEC 32 AND REFERENCED SAME. IN 1978 BARNES FD R/R SPIKE, 2 REFERENCE TIES & ACCEPTED SAME. IN 1985, SANDSNES FD ALUM. MON.

I DID NOT FIND A RECORD OF THE INSTALLATION OF THE ALUM @ THE SE COR SEC 32 IN THE ROCK COUNTY RECORDS. I DID NOT SEARCH THE DANE COUNTY RECORDS.
