AN IRON PIPE 1 1/2" 4" DIAMETER MAY BE USED IN AREAS WHERE GROUND WATER IS WITHIN ONE FOOT OF THE SURFACE. IF THE CORNER IS OCCUPIED BY AN IMPROVEMENT BARRHOLEDIFIED CABLE, ETC) AND DURABLE, DISTINCT MONUMENT MAY BE USED. CORNERS SHALL BE REFERENCED WITH AT LEAST 4 DURABLE WITNESS MONUMENTS. WITNESS MONUMENTS SHALL BE MADE OF CONCRETE, IRON PIPE, STONE, IRON OR OTHER EQUALLY DURABLE MATERIAL EXCEPT WOOD. DESCRIBE THE CORNER AND THE WITNESS MONUMENTS.
