




(a.) CORNER MONUMENT

O WITNESS MONUMENT



SHOW A PLAN VIEW DRAWING DEPICTING THE CORNER MONUMENT AND SURROUNDING PHYSICAL FEATURES, INCLUDING THE EXCAVATION FA.

AND DEPTH. THE CORNER MONUMENT SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING CHARACTERISTICS: 1) HAVE AT LEAST TWO PREDETERMINED BREAK-OFF
POINTS. 2) IF BROKEN, LEAVE A PERMANENTLY MAGNETIZED REMNANT AT THE ORIGINAL POINT. 3) MUST BE EXTENDABLE 4) THE CAP
IS INSCRIBED ROCK COUNTY SURVEY MONUMENT - PENALTY FOR DISTURBING MARKER. 5) OR AN EXISTING CUT LIMESTONE. AN IRON PIPE I' 4

4'O" (MINIMUM) MAY BE USED IN AREAS WHERE GROUND WATER IS WITHIN ONE FOOT OF THE SURFACE. IF THE CORNER IS OCCUPIED BY AN
IMPROVEMENT (MANHOLE, BURIED CABLE, ETC.) ANY DURABLE, DISTINCT MONUMENT MAY BE USED. CORNERS SHALL BE REFERENCED WITH AT
LEAST 4 DURABLE WITNESS MONUMENTS. WITNESS MONUMENTS SHALL BE MADE OF CONCRETE, NATURAL STONE, IRON OR OTHER EQUALLY DURABLE
MATERIAL, EXCEPT WOOD. DESCRIBE THE CORNER AND THE WITNESS MONUMENTS.



- 1858 CHURCH VOL 1 PG 84 USED CORNER TO SUBDIVIDE SECTION 35. STATES NOTHING ABOUT CORNER.
- 1868 LOCKE VOL 1 PG 326 FOUND HH SURROUNDED BY 4 OR 5 LIMESTONES. SET STAKE WITH HARDHEAD ON N & S AND LIMESTONES ON E & W IN CENTER OF HIGHWAY & IN LINE WITH N/S FENCE.
- 1881 LEE VOL 2 PG 335 COULD NOT FIND STAKE & STONES SET BY LOCKE, BUT FOUND STAKE SET BY HIM AT CENTER OF NORTH LINE OF NE QUARTER. ESTABLISHED QUARTER CORNER FROM THIS AND NE CORNER.
- 1967 BATTERMAN VOL 4 PG 336 DUG AND FOUND NOTHING.

DUG 7' DEEP AND FOUND NOTHING.

C) Was the corner restored through acceptance of (1) an obliterated evidence location, or, (2) a found perpetuated location?

LOCKE'S VARIANCE SHOWS THAT THE SOUTH QUARTER CORNER IS NOT ON LINE WITH THE SOUTH EAST AND SOUTH WEST CORNERS OF SECTION 26. I PRORATED LOCKE'S DISTANCE WITH THE DISTANCE THAT I MEASURED FROM THE SOUTH WEST CORNER OF SECTION 26 AND THE SOUTH 1/16th CORNER OF THE SOUTH EAST QUARTER OF SECTION 26. LOCKE STATED THAT THE CORNER IS IN THE CENTER OF THE ROAD. BASED ON THIS, I USED THE CENTER OF THE ROAD TO CONTROL THE N/S DIRECTION. THIS IS ALSO IN HARMONY WITH LEE'S DISTANCE TO THE EAST WEST QUARTER LINE OF SECTION 35.
