

- 1867 LEE VOL 1 PG 332 FOUND OLD STAKE AND SW BT. SHOWS 2630.76 TO THE CENTER OF SECTION 13.
- 1971 LEE VOL 4 PG 550 SET R/R SPIKE AND REFERENCED SAME. THAT THE CORNER IS ON LINE WITH THE NE AND NW CORNERS OF SECTION 13 AND 2651.05 FROM BOTH.
- 1971 LEE VOL 4 PG 549 SHOWS 2651.05 TO THE NE AND SE CORNERS OF SECTION 13.
- 1980 BARNES VOL 6 PG 85 SHOWS A R/R SPIKE AND CORNER IS ON LINE WITH THE SE AND NE CORNERS OF SECTION 13 AT MID POINT.
- 1980 BARNES VOL 6 PG 94 FOUND R/R SPIKE AS PLACED BY LEE. DISTANCES TO FENCES AND PAVEMENT.
- 1981 BARNES TOWNSHIP PROJECT SHOWS
- 1990 LLOYD JENSEN (WALWORTH COUNTY SURVEYOR)-LETTER. WE DUG AT THE RAILROAD SPIKE THAT WAS IN PLACE. AT ABOUT SIX (6) FEET DOWN, WE FOUND THE EAST SIDE OF AN OLD CORDUROY ROAD AND NO STAKE BELOW THE RAILROAD SPIKE. WE THEN DUG THE REMAINDER OF THE ROAD OUT AND FOUND A SMALL OLD STAKE ABOUT THREE (3) FEET BELOW THE ROAD SURFACE. ABOUT SIX (6) FEET BELOW THE ROAD SURFACE, WE FOUND THE OLD CORDUROY ROADBED AND IN THE CENTER OF THAT, WE FOUND AN OLD STAKE IN GOOD CONDITION. THE GROUND WAS VERY WET SO THE STAKE AND CORDURDY ROAD LOGS WERE IN FAIR CONDITION. THE SMALL STAKE THAT WE FOUND AT A POINT THREE (3) FEET BELOW THE ROAD SURFACE CHECKED WITH THE LARGE STAKE IN THE CENTER OF THE CORDUROY ROAD. THIS FOR THE LOCATION OF OUR MONUMENT.

FOUND JENSEN'S DISK IN A CONCRETE MONUMENT AND R/R SPIKE. Was the corner restored through acceptance of (1) an obliterated evidence location, or, (2) a found perpetuated location? ACCEPTED JENSEN'S CONCRETE MONUMENT.
