ROAD PAVEMENT WAS RELOCATED. BATTERMAN'S ENGINEER WAS IN CHARGE OF THE PROJECT. ROGK ROAD DID THE PAVING & EXCAVATION. HE STATED HE FOUND A CAST IRON MONUMENT, WHICH HE MARKED SO IT WOULD BE SAVED. HE PLACED A LATH 36' TO THE NW OF CI & 20' TO THE NE. THE NEXT DAY IT WAS REMOVED. I DUG 2.0' DEEP & DID NOT FIND THE BOTTOM OF THE CI. I PLACED AN ALUMINUM MONUMENT AT HARMONY DISTANCES TO THE FD MONUMENTS. THIS IS ALSO IN HARMONY WITH BATTERMAN'S LATH. THE MAP IN THE JANESVILLE COUNTY SURVEYORS' VOL 4 PAGE 450 SHOWS THE CORNER WEST OF THE N/S FENCE LINE. THE BELOIT SET CORRECTLY SHOWS THE LOCATION NEAR THE N/S FENCE LINE.
