
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



SHOW A PLAN VIEW DRAWING DEPICTING THE CORNER MONUMENT AND SURROUNDING PHYSICAL FEATURES, INCLUDING THE EXCAVATION AREA AND DEPTH. THE CORNER MONUMENT SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING CHARACTERISTICS: I) HAVE AT LEAST TWO PREDETERMINED BREAK-OFF POINTS. 2) IF BROKEN, LEAVE A PERMANENTLY MAGNETIZED REMNANT AT THE ORIGINAL POINT. 3) MUST BE EXTENDABLE. 4) THE CAP IS PRECIFIED. ROCK COUNTY SURVEY MONUMENT - PENALTY FOR DISTURBING MARKER. 5) OR AN EXISTING CUT LIMESTONE. AN IRON PIPE IN A 10" (MINIMUM) MAY BE USED IN AREAS WHERE GHOUND WATER IS WITHIN ONE FOOT OF THE SURFACE. IF THE CORNER IS OCCUPIED BY AN IMPROVEMENT (MANHOLE, BURIED CABLE, ETC.) ANY DURABLE, DISTINCT MONUMENT MAY BE USED. CORNERS SHALL BE REFERENCED WITH AT LEAST A DURABLE WITHESS MONUMENTS. WITNESS MONUMENTS SHALL BE MADE OF CONCRETE, NATURAL STONE, IRON OR OTHER EQUALLY DURABLE MATERIAL, EXCEPT WOOD. DESCRIBE THE CORNER AND THE WITNESS MONUMENTS.

1870 RUGER VOL 2 PG 29 FOUND REMAINS OF OLD STAKE & REMAINS OF STUMPS OF BEARING TREES. SET SANDSTONE 17x12x7 & SURROUNDED IT WITH 4 SANDSTONES.

1906 KERCH VOL 3 PG 38 FOUND 1/4 SEC COR AS SET BY RUGER. UNDER SOUTH END OF BRIDGE.

V1965 SHIMEALL PLAT OF SURVEY SHOWS PIN AT CORNER. ALSO PLACED REFERENCE TIES.

1980 COMES CSM VOL 10 PG 138 SHOWS A PK AT THE CORNER. 1986 COMES PLAT OF SURVEY. DOES NOT STATE WHAT HE FOUND.


