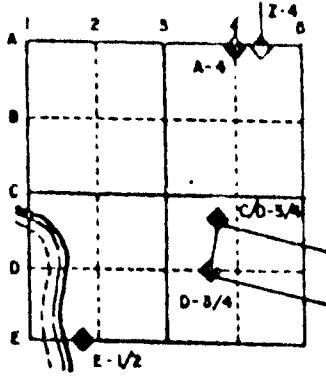

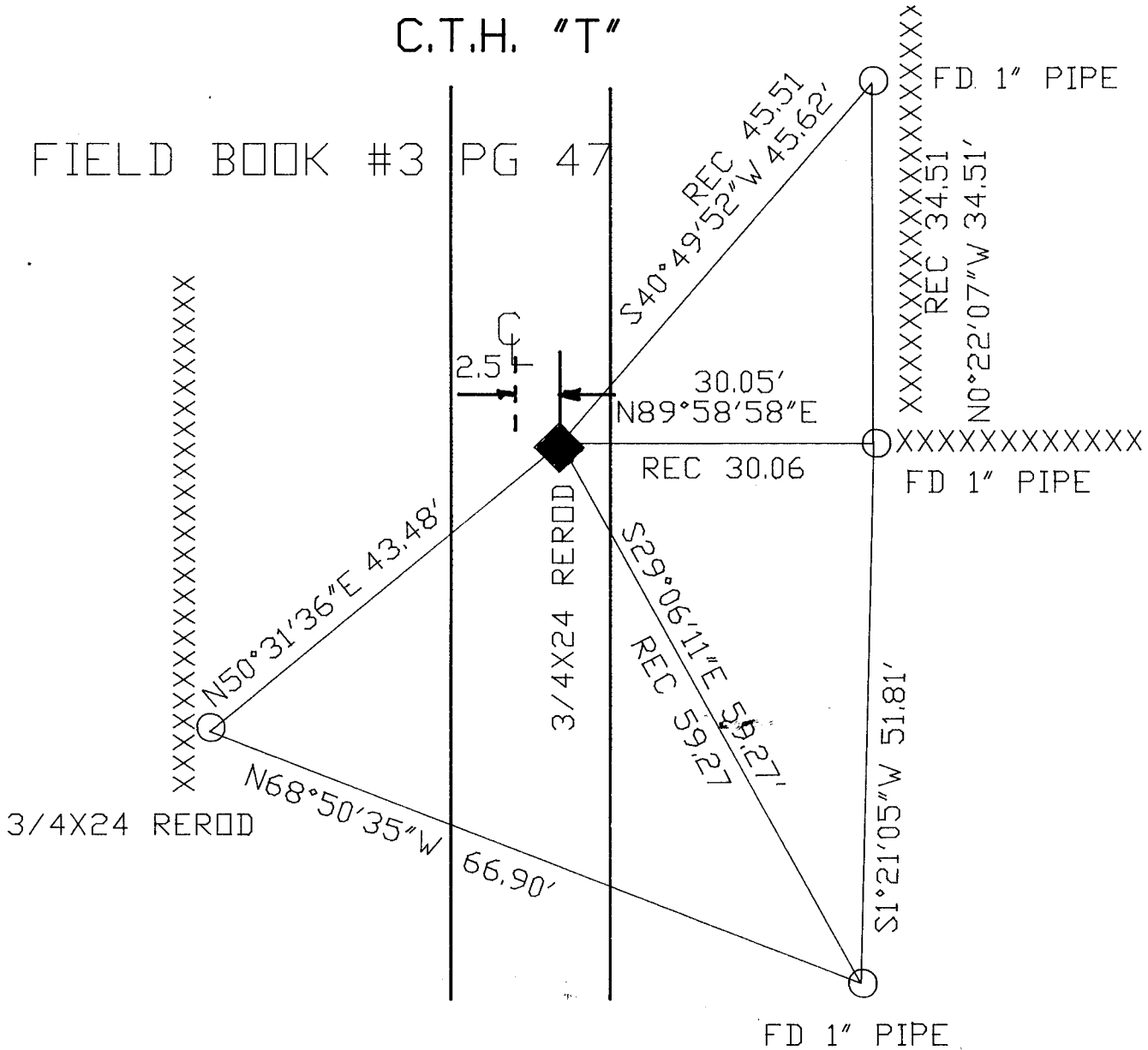

1877 RUGER VOL 2 PG 267 FOUND LIMESTONE AT COR SET BY LEE. CALLS FOR 1325.78 TO W 1/4 CORNER, 1325.78 TO NW CORNER, AND 1521.96 TO CENTER OF NW 1/4 OF SECTION 30.

1963 BATTERMAN JR. VOL 4 PG 159 FOUND LIMESTONE MON. REFERENCED SAME.

DUG AND FOUND 5X10X17 LIMESTONE ON END 2' DEEP. PLACED MAGNET ON EAST SIDE AND REFERENCED SAME. MONUMENT IS 3.5 EAST OF THE CENTER OF THE PAVEMENT.

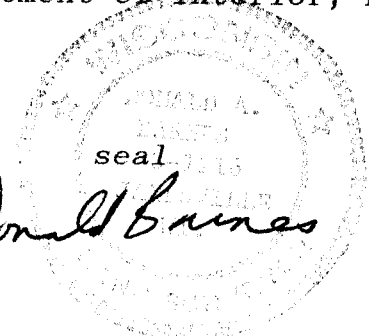
