No previous record of the center of section being set is on record. Construction of IH 90 certainly would have obliterated any corner evidence. A Bernsen model A-1-BR monument with a WIS DOT cap was set.


(c.) Was the corner restored through acceptance of (1) an obliterated evidence location, or, (2) a found perpetuated location?

The center of section 5 was set at the intersection of the East-West and North-South quarter lines.
