


 - 1855 CHURCH VOL 1 PG 34 STATES NOTHING ABOUT THE CORNER BUT SHOWS DISTANCES TO IT.
 - 1865 LOCKE FOUND STUMPS OF B. TREES.
 - 1868 LOCKE REMONUMENTATION NOTES. FOUND STUMPS OF B.T.s AND STONE SET ON CORNER IN CENTER OF HIGHWAY.
 - 1877 RUGER VOL 2 PG 234 SHOWS STONE MONUMENT ON MAP.
 - 1869 RUGER VOL 2 PG 1 FOUND MONUMENT.
 - 1938 SUNNY VOL 3 PG 391 DUG 7 X 7 X 5 DEEP AND FOUND NOTHING.

I DUG AND FOUND CUT LIME STONE LEANING AT ABOUT 60 DEGREES TO THE NORTH AND STONE SPLIT LENGTH WISE IN SEVERAL PIECES. LEFT STONE IN HOLE BUT NOT NEAR THE CORNER LOCATION. PLACED ALUMINUM MONUMENT. THE CORNER IS 7' SOUTH OF THE NORTH EDGE OF THE PAVEMENT.


