
LAND OWNER SAID DNR TRAPPED THE BEAVERS AND BLEW UP THEIR DAM LAST WINTER. FROM THE DIGITAL AIR PHOTOS IT APPEARS THAT THE WIDTH OF THE BROOK INCREASED SUBSTANTIALLY BECAUSE OF THE BEAVER DAM. CORNER FALLS IN THE BROOK. SEARCHED BROOK BOTTOM AND ALONG BANK AND DID NOT FIND CUT LIMESTONE NOR CONCRETE MONUMENT. RESTORED CORNER ON LINE & MIDWAY BETWEEN THE NE & SE CORNERS OF SECTION 13 NEWARK TWP AS COLLINS DID WHICH FITS BATTERMAN'S REFERENCE MONUMENT.

IN CENTER & PORTER TWP ALL THE CLOSURES OF THE WEST BOUNDARY WERE LARGE AND HARRISON SPECIFICALLY STATES SETTING A POST & RAISING A MOUND FOR MANY OF THE CORNERS. THE PLAT ALLS FOR JOGS AT ALL POINTS ALTHOUGH THE FIELD NOTES DO NOT STATE SO. THE PROBLEM IS THE FIELD NOTES, ORIGINAL PLAT, AND FIELD HISTORY ARE NOT ALWAYS IN HARMONY.

THE FOLLOWING RECORDS SHOW THAT THE ORIGINAL SURVEYOR, HARRISON, PLACED N/S JOGS AT THE SECTION CORNERS BETWEEN BELOIT & NEWARK TOWNSHIPS FROM THE SW COR SECTION 31 BELOIT TOWNSHIP TO THE NW CORNER OF SEC 19. THE ORIGINAL GOVERNMENT PLAT CALLS FOR ALL THE CORNERS BETWEEN NEWARK AND BELOIT TOWNSHIPS TO BE COMMON. THE QUESTION WHY DID HARRISON CHANGE HIS FIELD PROCEDURES FOR THE NW COR SEC 18 AND THE NW COR SEC 7. THE CLOSURES WERE GREATER THAN 10.56' AT THE SW COR SEC 30 WHERE HE ESTABLISHED THE CORNER. WHY DIDN'T THE ORIGINAL PLAT REFLECT HIS JOGS AS THEY DID IN PORTER & CENTER TOWNSHIPS.
