

1968 BATTERMAN JR. VOL 4 PG 376 SET 2" PIPE. CALLS FOR 2620.64 TO SE & SW CORNERS, 5310.28 TO N 1 /4 CORNERS OF SECTION 27. ANGLE 92-08-44 AT SW 27 FROM W 1/4 TO S 1/4 CORNERS OF SECTION 27.

FOUND 2"X36" PIPE LAYING 40' TO THE SE OF THE CORNER IN BRUSH LINE. USED BATTERMAN JR.'S RECORD ANGLES AND DISTANCES TO RESTORE THE POSITION. PLACED POLY. MON. ABOUT 18" DEEP. PLACED SEVERAL MAGNETS BY MONUMENT.
