THE CORNER MONUMENT SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING CHARACTERISTICS: 1) HAVE A LEAST TWO PREDETERMINED BREAK-OFF POINTS. 2) IF BROKEN LEAVE A PERMANENTLY MARKETIZED REMNANT AT THE ORIGINAL POINT. 3) MUST BE EXTENDABLE. 4) THE CAP IS INSCRIBED "ROCK COUNTY SURVEY MONUMENT - PENALTY FOR DISTURBING MARKER". 5) ON AN EXISTING CUT LIMESTONE, AN IRON PIPE 1 1/2" DIA. OR 2" DIA. PIPE MAY BE USED IN AREAS WHERE GROUND WATER IS WITHIN ONE FOOT OF THE SURFACE. IF THE CORNER IS OCCUPIED BY AN IMPROPERLY SHARPOURISHED CABLE, ETC. AND DURABLE, DISTINCT MONUMENT MAY BE USED. CORNERS SHALL BE REPLACED WITH AT LEAST 4 DURABLE WITNESS INSTRUMENTS. WITNESS MONUMENTS SHALL BE MADE OF CONCRETE, METAL, STONE, IRON OR OTHER EQUALLY DURABLE MATERIAL EXCEPT WOOD. DESCRIBE THE CORNER AND THE WITNESS MONUMENTS.
