THE CORNER MONUMENT SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING CHARACTERISTICS: 1) HAVE A LEAST TWO PREDETERMINED BREAK-OFF POINTS; 2) IF BROKEN, LEAVE A PERMANENTLY MAGNETIZED REMNANT AT THE ORIGINAL POINT; 3) MUST BE EXTENDABLE; 4) THE CAP IS INSCRIBED "ROCK COUNTY SURVEY MONUMENT - PENALTY FOR DISTURBING MARKER"; 5) OR AN EXISTING CUT LIMESTONE; AN IRON PIPE 1 1/2" 4" DIAMETER MAY BE USED IN AREAS WHERE GROUND WATER IS WITHIN ONE FOOT OF THE SURFACE; IF THE CORNER IS OCCUPIED BY AN IMPROVEMENT (BARN/POLYMERIZED CABLE, ETC) AND DURABLE, DISTINCT EQUIPMENT MAY BE USED. CORNERS SHALL BE REFERENCED WITH AT LEAST 4 DURABLE WITNESS INSTRUMENTS. WITNESS MONUMENTS SHALL BE MADE OF CONCRETE, BURNED STONE, IRON OR OTHER EQUALLY DURABLE MATERIAL EXCEPT WOOD. DESCRIBE THE CORNER AND THE WITNESS MONUMENTS.
