before Edward Inman a Justice of the Peace in said town, upon the 9<sup>th</sup> day of September 1872 and said commissioners did decide to reverse the determination of said Supervisors made July 6<sup>th</sup> 1872.

Now therefore pursuant to said decision we the said Supervisors do hereby order and determine that said highway described as follows: Commencing in the center of the Beloit and Delevan Road at the Sections corners of Sections No. 31 & 32 on the North side of Turtle Creek and running; thence South about One Hundred rods on or near the Section line of Sections No. 31 & 32. Town 2 North of Range 14 East to within 2 rods of a stone wall and to the center of a highway running Easterly and passing the house of Wm. Wyman and crossing in its course Turtle Creek and lands owned and occupied by Wm. Wyman be and the same is hereby discontinued.

Order for Alteration of Highway Town of Bradford

Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residents in said Town of Bradford for the altering of a highway as hereinafter discribed. we the undersigned Supervisors of said town did on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May 1873 make out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon said application and did meet on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of May 1873 at 10 o'clock in the forenoon of said day at John Monroes it being the time and place fixed by us in said notice and having first been satisfied that the notice aforesaid had been duly given five days previous to the time of our said meeting to all the occupants of the lands through which said highway passes and had also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meeting in the manner required by law we did then and there proceed to examine personally said highway and did hear all reasons offered for and against the altering of the same and did decide upon said application and it being our opinion the the public good will be promoted did decide to alter said highway as hereinafter discribed. Now therefore pursuant to said application we the supervisors do hereby order and determine that said highway be altered as follows:

Commencing at the S.W. Corner of the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 13 in the Town of Bradford and running to a point in the center
