occupants of the lands through said highways pass, and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days previous to the time of said meeting, it is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine be and the same is hereby laid out described as follows; to wit commencing at the point where the quarter line on section five intersects the road running southwest from Footville, thence running south on said quarter line to the quarter post on the south line of said section five; thence south on the quarter line of section eight to the quarter post in the center of said section eight the line of survey to be the center of said highway and the same is established four rods in width.

Also to discontinue a highway in said town of Plymouth described as follows to wit: commencing at a point where said highway intersects road running to Footville known as the Douglass road, near the southeast corner of section four running west on the section line between sections four and nine, five and eight to the point where said highway intersects road running southwest from Footville, pursuant to said application.

The undersigned freeholders and residents of the town of Plymouth and county of Rock do hereby make application to you to lay out a highway described as follows; Commencing at a point where the quarter line on section five intersects the road running south west from Footville, thence running South on the quarter line of sections five and eight to the point where of the quarter line post in the center of section eight.

They also make application to you to discontinue a highway in said town of plymouth described as follows:
