We the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Magnolia agreeable to Notice to the effect this day met the Commissioners of the Town of Center & have laid out and established the above petitioned for road as a public Highway four rods wide, the line being the center of the same and that one mile and eighty rods of the North end of the same is a part of road District No. 3 belonging to this Town.

At a meeting of the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Magnolia all the said commissioners having been duly notified to attend the said meeting for the purpose of deliberating upon the subject matter embraced in this order, it is ordered and determined by the said Commissioners that a Highway be laid out in said Town of the width of four rods and the said Commissioners have caused a survey thereof to be made as follows: the center line of said Highway is to commence in center of the Territorial Road in Janesville to Mineral Point upon the center line of Section 18 Town 3 North of Range 10 E. and run thence North along said center line 41 chains to the quarter post upon the line between Sections 7 and 18 of said Town on North in a direct line to the quarter post upon the line between Section 6 & 7, 40 chains to the center of a Highway East & West throu the center of said Section No. 7.

In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands at Magnolia this 21 st Day of Jan. 1848.

I do hereby certify that there was three Public Notices posted up for six days previous to laying out a road commencing at the center of Sec. 18 and running North to the center of Section 7. Joshua Durben

At a meeting of the Commissioners of Highways of the Town of Magnolia the commissioners of said Town having met and deliberated upon the subject matter embraced in this order it is ordered and determined that a Highway be laid out of the width of three rods and have ordered a survey thereof to be made as follows; to wit, the Center line of said road is to commence in the Center of the Highway running from Sugar River Road southerly past Samuel & Joseph Reeds at the corner of Section 1,2,11,& 12 and run thence West along the line between Sections 2 & 11, 40 chains an to the quarter post on the along said line, 10 chains & 84 links to the center of the Highway running South from the Sugar River Road past Boviyes & J. Jones the line being the center of said road. Magnolia. March 11, 1849.
