Page 127 of the Record Town of Magnolia

Whereas upon the application of twenty nine freeholders residing in said town of Magnolia for the laying out of a highway as herein after discribed we the undersigned Supervisors of said town did on the 1st day of March 1875 make out a notice and fix herein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and did meet on the 13th day of March 1875 at 10 o'clock in the forenoon of said day at the house of A.M. Rowley in said town it being the time and place fixed by us in said notice and having first been satisfied that the notice aforsaid had been duly given five days previous to the time of our said meeting to all the occupants of the lands through which said highway passes and had been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meeting in the manner required by law we did then and there proceed to examine personally said highway and did hear all reasons that were offered for or against laying out the same and decide upon such application and it being our opinion that the public good will thereby be promoted did decide to lay out said highway as herein after discribed. Now therefor personally to said application we the said Supervisors do hereby order and determine that a highway be and the same is hereby layed out as follows, to wit: Beginning at a point in the highway at the South East corner of the N.E. 4 of Sec. 11 in said town and running thence South West to the Western boundary of the highway running North and South on the Section line between Sec. 11 and Section 12 thence West to intercept the highway running North from Magnolia corners the center line of Section 11 to be the Northern boundary of said highway the same being an accurate survey thereof caused by us to be made, the line of said survey is the center of said highway and the same is layed out of the width of four rods.
