At a meeting of the comissioners of highways of the town of Flymouth the commmissioners having met and deliberated on the subject embraced in this order, it is ordered and determined by said commissioners that a highway be laid out in said town of the width of three rods and said commissioners have caused a survey there of to be made as follows; the center line of said highway is to commence at the north west corner of Section twenty five; thence running South on the Section six to the south west corner of said Section twenty five; thence South on the Section line between Section thirty five and Section thirty six terminating on the South line of said town the center of highway to be on the section line. Commencing st the South West corner of Sections 33 in town 2 North of Range 11 Mast running North on Sections 33 & 28 until opposite the quarter stake between Sections 28 & 29. We ziged or zaged two rods or fifty links to the rear and laid said road on the line
