At a meeting of the commissioners of highways of the town of Plymouth the commissioners having met and deliberated on the subject embraced in this order, it is ordered and determined by said commissioners that a highway be laid out in said town of the width of three rods and said commissioners have caused a survey there of to be made as follows; the center line of said highway is to commence at the north west corner of Section twenty five; thence running South on the Section six to the south west corner of said Section twenty five; thence South on the Section line between Section thirty five and Section thirty six terminating on the South line of said town the center of highway to be on the section line. In witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands at Plymouth on the 26th day of March 1849

At a meeting of the Supervisors of the town of Plymouth held at the house of Peter McGleishens on the 29th and 30th days of June 1849 for the purpose of laying out a road after examining the ground we determined to lay out a Public Highway commencing at the quarter stake between 20 and 29 in Town 2, North Range 11E. running west until it intersects the Road leading from Beloit to Monroe and the same is hereby declared to be a public highway four rods in width a description of which is given in the Survey bill hereunto annexed and made a part of this order. Description of road Surveyed by me in the town of Plymouth, Rock County, Wisconsin. Commencing at quarter stake between Sections 20 and 29 and running S. 88° W. on Section line between Section 20 and 29 and 19 & 30. 75 chains and 50 links to the middle of Monroe and Beloit road Var. of compass 80°.

At a meeting of the Supervisors of the Town of Plymouth held at the house of Nathan Whitman on the 30th day of June 1849 for the purpose of laying out a public road four rods wide. Commencing at the South West corner of Sections 33 in town 2 North of Range 11 East running North on Sections 33 & 28 until opposite the quarter stake between Sections 28 & 29. We zigged or zaged two rods or fifty links to the rear and laid said road on the line
