Normans house is hereby altered so as to commence at the N. W. Corner W.1/2 N.E.1/4 of Section 21) in said town running thence North thirty rods more or less on the center line of Section 16 in said town to intersect the highway first North of said State road the same being an accurate survey thereof caused by us to be made, the line of said highway is the center of said highway, and the same is laid out of the width of four Pods.
