Whereas on the applacation of six freeholders of the Town of Magnolia in said County for the laying out of a highway hereinafter described we the undersigned Supervisors of said Town did on the 8th day of October 1860 meet at the place of commencement of said road in said Town for the purpose of then and there deciding upon such application it being the time and place fixed for that purpose did proceed to examine personally such Highway and having then and here heard such reasons as were offered for and against the same did determine to lay out such Highway as herein after described having as required by law first made out a Notice and fixed therein a time and place at which to meet and decide upon such application and the applicant for such Highway having five days previous to our meeting caused such Notice to be duly given to all the occupants of the lands through which such Highway passes and such Notice having also been posted up in three public places in said Town ten days before the time of our said meeting it is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that a Highway be and the same is hereby laid out pursuant to such application whereof an accurate survey has been made which is as follows to wit: Beginning at a point in the center of the Highway running East and West and to intersect a Highway leading from Spring-Valley North through the center of said Town of Magnolia and running thence on or near the line between Sections nine and ten and three and four to the South line of the Town of Union viz; to run from the place of commensement North one hundred and forty eight rods for the line between sections nine and ten said line to be the center of said Road thence to angle four rods East in running six rods North, thence North parallel with the said Section line to the creek, thence angle West two rods an running four rods North, thence North all on the East side of the Section line between Section three and four to the South line of the Town of Union said Road to be four rods in width.
