Order for Laying Out Highway

Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town of Flymouth for the laying out of a highway as hereinafter described we the undersigned supervisors of said town, did on the fourth day of March 1873 made out a notice and fix therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and did meet on the 17th of March 1873, at ten o'clock in the forenoon of said day at the house of August Deckman, it being the time and place fixed by us in said notice and having first been satisfied, that the notice aforesaid, had been duly give, five days previous to the time of our said meeting to all the occupants of the lands through which said highway passes, and had also been posted up in three sublic places in said town ten days previous to our said meeting in the manner required by law we did then and there proceed to examine personally said highway, and hear all ressons that were offered for or against laying out the same, and did decide upon such application, and it being our opinion that the public good will be thereby promoted, did decide to lay out said highway, as hereinafter described. Now therefore pursuant to said application we the said supervisors do hereby order and determine that a highway be, and the same is hereby laid out as follows: Commencing two roas North of the center of section 14; thence mast parallel with the center line 87 rods,; thence North 4 rods; thence East until it crosses the creek, the highbonk of the creek, the Southwest line of the road, until it intersects the center line; thence Bast on the center line, to the Southwest corner of the Ma of the N. w. > of Section 13,; thence South two rods; thence hast to the town line. The line of said survey to be the center of said highway and the same is established four rods in width.
