Whereas upon the application of six freeholders residing in said town of Magnolia for the altering of a Highway as herein after described, we the undersigned Supervisors of said town did on the 22nd day of June 1872 make out a notice and fix there in a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such application and did meet on the 2nd day of July 1872 at 2 o'clock in the afternoon of said day at the house of Aaron Smith it being the time & place fixed by us in said notice. The owner and occupant of the land through which said highway passes not having been legaley notified, but waving his objections and the notice having been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of said meeting in the manner required by law; we did then & there proceed to examine personally said highway and did here all reasons that were offered for or against the altering, the same, and did decide upon such application and it being our opinion that the public good will there by be promoted, did decide to alter said Highway as herein after discribed. Now therefore persuant to said application we the said Supervisors do hereby order and determine that the highway between Section 20 & 29 in said town be altered as follows: Commencing one hundred and twenty rods West of the East line of said Section 20 & 29 in said town of Magnolia; the center of the road shall be one rod South of the Section line between said Sections twenty (20) & 29 running thence twenty rods West: thence one rod North to said Section line and the same is laid out the width of four rods.
