Where as upon the application of six freeholders residing in the said town of Plymouth for the altering of a highway herein after described we the undersigned supervisors of said town did on the 19th day of March A. B. 1860 meet at he house of E. Wade in said town for the purpose of then and there deceding upon such application it being the time and place fixed by us for that purpose did proceed to examine personally such highway and having then and there heard such ressons as were offered for and against altering the same did then and there decide upon such application and determine to alter said highway as herein after described having as required by law first made out a notice and fixed therein a time and place at which we would meet and decide upon such a application and the applicant for such highway having five days previous to our said meeting caused such notice to le duly given to all the occupants of the land through which said highway passes and such notice having also been posted up in three public places in said town ten days before the time of our said meeting; It is ordered and determined and we do hereby order and determine that said highway is hereby altered as follows. To wit: persuant to said application whereof and accurate survey has been made which is as follows to wit. Commencing two rods East of the North West corner of the South East quarter of the North East quarter of Section thirty, town 2, kange 11 East: thence South 45° East to a stake standing three rods North on the East line from the South East corner of the above described land thence South 85% East 556 links to the center of the territorial or state road. The line of said survey to be the center of said highway and the same is established four rods in width.
