The said Highway to run from the Galens road at or about the S.E. Corner of the S.W.¼ of Section 35 Town 3 N. of R. 10 East to a Road called John Craces'Road running South from S.W. Corner of S.E.¼ of Section 32 of same town.

At a meeting of the Supervisors of said Magnolia agreeable to previous notice given and having examined and deliberated upon the subject herein embraced, it is ordered and determined by the said Supervisors, that a highway be lain out in said town of the width of four rods, and caused a survey, thereof to be made as follows; beginning near the North East corner of Section 2 in said town running thence West along the North line of said Section 2, to the road leading from Magnolia to Evansville, the whole width of four rods in Magnolia.
